# **NEW DAR-E-MEHR BUILDING PROJECT** AT

# 106 POMONA ROAD, SUFFERN, NEW YORK

### OUR MISSION

To build a new Dar-e-Mehr that reflects a Zoroastrian ambience and better fulfills the cultural, religious and social needs of the current community and future generations. This would encourage active participation of the growing community and maintain Zarathushti identity, while preserving cultural traditions and creating a sense of belonging for members.

### CASE FOR CHANGE



The present Dar-e-Mehr is located on a beautiful 3.5-acre property. However, the building is not functional for our needs as it is too small for cultural, religious and social community gatherings and events (Navroze, Navjote / Sudreh-Pushi Ceremonies, Weddings, Conferences etc.). Furthermore, its prayer hall is inadequate and the outside facade has no Zoroastrian character. The building requires extensive repairs, maintenance and updates. Renovation and expansion to current code was considered and found, not only to be almost as expensive as new construction, but still lacking in Zoroastrian character.

## NEEDS FOR THE CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

With community input, a 22,000 sq. ft. state-of-the-art building that reflects a Zoroastrian ambience has been designed. This building incorporates the identified needs of our community:

- A Prayer Hall that accommodates 100 people & includes features resembling an Atash Khadeh,
- A large Main Hall that seats close to 400 people and has good acoustics,
- An inviting outside facade and Foyer,
- A formal Library,
- Seven Class / Meeting Rooms,
- A Recreation / Game Room.
- A well equipped Kitchen and Serving Area,
- Adequate Restroom facilities, and
- A spacious Coatroom.

The entire property, including the new Dar-e-Mehr building, will continue to be called the "Arbab Rustam Guiv Dar-e-Mehr Zoroastrian Temple" in honor of our original benefactor.

Donors for the new Dar-e-Mehr building will be recognized appropriately at the various donation

levels – \$1,000 - \$4,999; \$5,000 - \$9,999;

\$10,000 - \$14,999;

\$15,000 - \$24,999: \$25,000 - \$49,999; \$50.000 - \$99.999

Donors contributing over \$100,000 or more, will be recognized by appropriate room naming rights at the various donation levels -



\* Additional areas may be allocated room naming rights if the number of donors at the \$100,000 and \$200,000 donation levels exceed the number of rooms currently available.

\*\* If there are multiple donors at this level, all such donors will be recognized for the respective room.

The existing Dar-e-Mehr Donation Recognition Board will continue to be displayed at a suitable area in the New Dar-e-Mehr.



### DONOR STATISTICS AS OF MAY 31, 2015



# **CURRENT STATUS AND TIMELINE**

#### **CURRENT STATUS**

- ✓ June 5, 2015: Ground floor poured and the "Sagan" box, filled with auspicious items at the Ceremonial Groundbreaking in March 2014, placed under the Kebla flooring.
- Inside framing is well on it's way and will be completed in June.
- ✓ Electrical and plumbing work will commence.

#### TIMELINE:

- PROJECT INITIATED by a committed group of 16 individuals on October 10, 2010.
- PRESENTED final plans and estimated costs to the community on October 6, 2013.
- APPROVED proposal to start construction by 90.5% majority vote at DMZT Special General Body Meeting on December 8, 2013.
- FINAL SITE PLAN APPROVALS obtained from the village of Pomona on March 13, 2014.
- CEREMONIAL GROUNDBREAKING held on March 29, 2014.
- START CONSTRUCTION TRIGGER POINT of \$3.5 million crossed when additional \$300,000 raised on March 29, 2014.
- CONTRACT AWARDED to REDCOM Design & Construction, LLC on May 9, 2014.
- FAREWELL Jashan and dinner for existing Darbe Mehr on July 5, 2014.
- > FINAL SITE PERMITS received August 5, 2014.
- > CONSTRUCTION STARTED August 6, 2014.
- OCTOBER 2014 Completed demolition of existing Dar-e-Mehr building; Property graded; Underground storm water retention system completed.
- NOVEMBER 2014 Building foundation footings completed.
- JANUARY 2015 Floor slab poured & steel structure frame erected.
- MARCH 2015 Roof framing completed; Elevator shaft completed.
- APRIL MAY 2015 Roof Completed; Side wall Insulation completed; Underground utilities completed; Upper level flooring poured.
- RAISE the final \$1 Million during the construction period, of which approximately \$475,000 remains to be raised now.
- COMPLETE construction of the new building by December 2015 by keeping cash flow ahead of construction expenses.
